



Stryker launches expensive Mako robot for knee replacement in cost-conscious era

As value-based care and bundled payments begin to take hold in the orthopedics industry and healthcare overall, Kalamazoo, Michigan-based Stryker is doing something counterintuitive.

It is launching an expensive piece of equipment. Coinciding with the first day of the annual meeting of the American Academy of Orthopaedics Surgeons (AAOS) in San Diego, the orthopedics company announced Tuesday that the MAKO robot is now officially launched in the U.S. to perform total knee replacements. (MAKO has been available to perform total hip knee replacements and partial knees in the U.S. up until now.)

A second attempt to pass a replacement for the Affordable Care Act (ACA) has succeeded by the slimmest of margins in the US House of Representatives on a 217-213 vote. No Democrats voted for the legislation, but twenty moderate Republicans primarily from the Midwest and Northeast voted against it.

Submitting CEUs

CSAs must recertify every 2 years. Part of the recertification requirement is to submit 50 continuing education units (CEUs) within those 2 years. CEUs need to be received by the NSAA 30 days prior to your certification expiration date to provide enough time for verification and processing, and for NCCSA to process your CSA recertification certificate. NSAA will send out emails to its members 60 days prior to your expiration date as a reminder. Please check your email spam settings to ensure that you are able to receive emails from info@nsaa.net.

Checking CEU Status

You can check where you stand with your CEU count in the members area section of the website. Go to <u>www.nsaa.net</u> and click on 'members area' at the top and log-in. If you have trouble logging in please call the office at 855-270-6722. This is a great way to know how many CEUs you have on file at any given time. This information is updated about 72 hours after CEUs are submitted to NSAA. Once you submit CEUs, we encourage you to check your member profile to ensure your CEUs were properly received and recorded.
